Dr.Emin Ergen is a sports medicine specialist physician. He worked as a visiting assistant at Italian National Olympic Committee Sports Medicine Centre between 1982-1983. He also completed a post graduate (M.Sc.) program in sport sciences at Loughborough University (England) between 1987-1988. Dr.Emin Ergen is currently working at Ankara University School of Medicine Sports at the Sports Medicine Department as a full-time professor.

Dr.Ergen was elected as a member of executive board to European Federation of Sports Medicine Associations (EFSMA) in 2003 and to International Sports Medicine Federation (FIMS) in 2006. Dr.Ergen is also acting chairman of International Archery Federation (FITA) Medicine and Sport Science Commission and member of European Olympic Committees Medical and Sports Science Commission since 2001. Besides his academic and administrative commitments, he has been involved in team doctor duties in Mediterranean (1993-1997) and Olympic (1996-2000) Games. Dr.Ergen was the founding president of Sports For All(1991) and University Sports Federations(1993) in Turkey.
